The present teaching staff comprises of 1 administrative principal, 1 administrative deputy principal, 26 Class Teachers (24 mainstream and 2 ASD), 9 SEN teachers, and 19 SNAs. This school is a child-centred, happy and safe environment where all the children are encouraged to learn, and grow, to the best of their individual strengths and abilities. In addition to high academic expectations, pupils are provided with opportunities to participate in a wide range of extra-curricular activities. The successful candidate must have excellent people management and communication skills and an ability to foster positive relationships with pupils, parents and the wider community in order to lead and maintain a happy, active, and progressive school community.

Applicants must be registered with the Teaching Council of Ireland and show evidence of, and commitment to, ongoing professional development.
