The Position

This is a Part-Time Fixed-Term Special Education Teacher position of 23 hours. It will initially be for 15 hours for the month of September increasing by 8 hours to 23 hours from the 1st October once our census figures are confirmed by the Department. (Once figures are confirmed all extra hours owed for month of Sept will be backdated – we need 119 pupils to earn the extra 8 hours and presently have 135 enrolled).

As a developing school we present a unique opportunity for the right candidate to progress their career and quickly become a key staff member in what is a rapidly developing school with new and often permanent positions created year on year. Staff members must be prepared to be very flexible in what is a new school and so a constantly evolving environment. We are in temporary accommodation at the moment but will move to a brand new 24 classroom building in late 2018/early 2019. The successful candidate must be ready to start school on the 28th of August 2017.

National Vetting Bureau & Teaching Council Registration

All new employees must be Garda Vetted under the new arrangements made with the Teaching Council. They must also be registered with the Teaching Council. The school must have proof of this before a teacher is allowed to take up work.
