This role sits within the wider Public Engagement Division and is key to the fulfilment of Trócaire's dual mandate.

- Seek opportunities for collaboration with other DE organisations through the promotion of the Trócaire's Connecting for Impact partnership scheme
- Deliver outreach in schools and parishes as part of Trócaire's Lenten Campaign and other key initiatives
- Provide training and support for school volunteers
- Ensure all interactions with stakeholders are recorded on Trócaire's CRM system; and using the CRM system to inform and enhance supporter relations
- Employ quantitative and qualitative monitoring and evaluation practices and support the development of new tools to evaluate and measure impact in an educational context
