Experiment in International Living (EIL) Ireland is a not for profit organisation promoting intercultural learning experiences and inspiring global citizenship. EIL arrived in Ireland in 1964 and is now recognised as an educational charity. Whilst primarily welcoming international students to spend a secondary school year in Ireland, EIL also provides educational programmes for older adults through the Road Scholar lifelong learning programme, and the EIL Explore programme was established in 1994 to provide scholarships to Irish participants to study, volunteer, and travel abroad. Since then hundreds of Irish people from all backgrounds have had fully funded intercultural learning experiences around the world.

EIL are looking to recruit secondary school teachers to act as a local co-ordinator in their school. Local coordinators are responsible for managing a group of 10 to 15 international students, agreeing placement in their school, placing students with host families in their community, and delivering intercultural learning curriculum.

Additionally, the local coordinator can work with the EIL office to plan and develop student and staff mobility projects in their school. EIL are a member of the European Federation of Intercultural Learning (EFIL) with access to a network of International schools eager to develop new and innovative mobility projects.

Local coordinators are paid on a per student or per project basis.
