St Finian's NS, Dillonstown is a co-ed Primary School with two special classes for autism. St. Finian's is a rural school with 98 on roll. Our school motto is "Respect, Learn, Grow Toghether' The school has a Catholic ethos and is under the patronage of the Catholic Arch-Bishop of Armagh. The Board of Management of St. Finian's NS invites applications for the position of Administrative Principal. This is a permanent position, commencing on August 28th 2024.

The present staff comprises of 4 Mainstream Class Teachers, 2 Special Education Teachers, 2 Special class teachers, seven S.N.As, 1 secretary, 1 cleaner and 2 bus escorts.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria: Fully registered under Route 1 (Primary) with the Teaching Council and have 5 years recognised teaching service, two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland.

Specific Roles and Responsibilities for this position relate to the four domains of Leadership and Management, taken from 'Looking at our School, 2022: A Quality framework for Primary Schools and Special Schools'.

A commitment to shared leadership and a willingness to delegate and develop leadership capacity and empower others.
