The Governing Body invites applications from suitably qualified persons for the position of part-time Module Leader/Instructor.

GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION

Marino Institute of Education wishes to recruit an experienced education experts in primary mathematics education for the 2024-25 academic year. Interviews will be held as needed and applications will remain active for up to 12 months.

Applications are welcome from primary mathematics education experts who are interested in leading a module or teaching on a module on the Master in Education Studies (Primary Mathematics) degree programme. The modules are taught fully online in semester 1 and semester 2 of the 2024-2025 academic year. Each module consists of 16 hours of synchronous tuition (on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday evenings) and 9 hours of asynchronous tuition. Candidates may also be required to assess student work and provide detailed feedback to students on the course.

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS

In order to be considered for the position of Module Leader/Instructor, applicants must demonstrate the following:

- A level-10 qualification (on the National Framework of Qualifications) in mathematics education or a relevant discipline. This is a requirement for a module leader. For a module instructor, a level-9 qualification with progress towards a level-10 qualification may be considered.
- At least 3-years' experience of teaching mathematics in primary schools
- Excellent knowledge and understanding of mathematics education theories, policy and curricula relevant to primary education
- Knowledge of mathematics education research methods
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and organisational skills
- Strong work ethic.

Desirable

- Experience working in an online environment (including Teams and Zoom)
- Publications in peer-reviewed journals and research conference presentation experience
