The position advertised is for a Special Needs Assistant for Stratford National School. Stratford National School is a small, co-educational, multi-grade primary school in the heart of Rathgar, Dublin 6. The school shares a campus with Stratford College Co-educational Secondary School and has four mainstream classes, and two autism classes which opened in September 2023. It operates under the patronage of the Dublin Talmud Torah and has a Jewish ethos. Enrolment consists of pupils from a wide range of cultural backgrounds and the school welcomes children of all religions and none. Diversity and inclusion are cherished by the school.

This post is a 0.83 hours, permanent post. The successful candidate is expected to carry out the duties as per Circular 0030/2014 and relevant updated notices and/or circulars.

To meet the needs of the school the following competencies are desirable:

- Knowledge and experience of working with children with ASD and/or complex needs.
- Experience of working with children with challenging behaviour and promotion of positive behaviour strategies.
