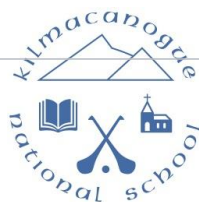

The present teaching staff comprises currently of 1 Admin Principal, 10 Class Teachers, 3 SET, 1 part time EAL, 1 ASD Teacher and 5 SNAs. Our aim is to develop each child's personal, spiritual and educational potential in a respectful, friendly, safe and inclusive teaching and learning environment in collaboration with parents, guardians and the wider community.

Applicants must be registered with the Teaching Council of Ireland (Route 1 - Primary), be fully Garda vetted and have a minimum of 5 years teaching experience in a recognised primary school in Ireland.

An in-depth knowledge of the Primary Curriculum and a range of teaching experience.

Understanding and knowledge of the requirements associated with the provision of Special Education Needs, inclusion and diversity. Evidence of ongoing experience in the provision of education to children in an ASD class and the facilitation of their educational provision.

Evidence of management and communication skills as well as evidence of the ability to foster

positive relationships with pupils, parents and the wider community.  
Evidence of the leadership skills associated with all aspects of school life with particular reference to school self-evaluation and curricular development.  
Evidence of commitment to relevant and ongoing continuing professional development.
