Scoil Bhríde is a co-educational vertical mainstream school with a special class for students with autism, 18 teaching posts and 8 Special Needs Assistants

Scoil Bhride is currently at Stage 2B of a building project to extend the school to accommodate a 2 Classroom ASD Suite.
