An internal panel of suitable applicants may be set up to fill vacancies which may occur within a specific time period (four months for teacher posts and the duration of the school year for SNA posts) from the date on which the Board approves the successful candidate.

Additional Information:

This position is part-time 0.5 of a post (16 hours over five days). Hours of work are based on the needs of the school. As with all positions in schools, SNAs can be assigned to any SNA position in the school at any time at the discretion of the school principal.

Placement may be in a mainstream class, an Autism class or a Moderate General Learning difficulties class.

Appointment is subject to Garda vetting requirements, Occupational Health requirements and completion of TUSLA Online Child Safeguarding Training Module.

Candidates should be energetic, flexible, trustworthy, able to work well as part of a team, respect the school ethos and have a strong work ethic. They should also have experience working as an SNA in a classroom setting with students with complex needs. They must be willing to undertake CPD courses which relate to the needs of the children & the school. Candidates will be required to fulfil all hours relevant to their day and contractual hours.

Experience of working with autistic children, children with moderate general learning difficulties and children with sensory needs is essential. Experience in Lámh and positive behaviour strategies is desirable.

Experience working with students with emotional and behavioural difficulties, ADHD, and general learning difficulties is desirable.
