- Working holiday visas: for eligible countries, 30-35 years and under may be able to travel to NZ and work casually, for up to three years (T&Cs apply). This is an excellent way to have an initial 'look-see' at Aotearoa and work in some NZ schools while travelling and seeing the country at the same time.
- Accredited Employer Work Visa Over 35 or ineligible for a Working holiday visa? If you have a job offer from a school, this work visa allows you to secure a visa for up to 5 years.
- Pathways to Residency: The NZ Government has opened the country for SKILLED MIGRANT

immigration and for those teachers in full time ongoing employment, pathways for a straight residency visa is now an option.
