- An ability to communicate and work collaboratively with school staff and support personnel;
- A high level of understanding and knowledge of special educational needs, inclusion and differentiation;
- A commitment to maintaining the high standards of teaching, learning and pupil wellbeing already established within the school;
- The ability to effectively manage the day-to-day operation of the school and ensure the continued smooth running of school procedures and routines.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria and be fully registered under Route 1 (Primary) with the Teaching Council. The successful candidate will be required to provide proof of qualifications.
