For the 2026/2027 school year, we will have mainstream classes from Junior Infants to Sixth Class, along with one autism class. We are currently based on the Notre Dame Campus in Churchtown and will move in time to a purpose-built school on Goatstown Road, beside Goatstown Educate Together Secondary School.

We are seeking applications for a permanent Special Education Teaching post. While this is a permanent Special Education Teaching post, initial duties may be in a mainstream classroom setting and may be subject to change in line with the needs of the school.
